JOSLYN IS FOR EVERYONE

Joslyn Art Museum features works from antiquity to the present with an emphasis on 19th- and 20th-century European and American art, and is renowned for its Western American collection. We are committed to providing quality exhibitions, programming, and education that is accessible to a broad audience.

PARKING

Accessible parking is available in the Parking Garden northeast of the Museum. The entry plaza drive (the granite-paved drive surrounding the *Sioux Warrior* sculpture just east of the building) is available for passenger pick-up and drop-off close to the Museum's atrium entrance.

WHEELCHAIRS

Wheelchairs are available on a first-come, first-served basis at the atrium entrance Visitor Services desk. Joslyn's entire building and sculpture gardens are completely accessible.

RESTROOMS

All restrooms are wheelchair accessible. Locations are marked on the Museum map. Maps can be found at the Visitor Services desk and the Scott EdTech Gallery.

SERVICE ANIMALS

Service animals are allowed to assist visitors inside the Museum.

ELEVATORS

The Museum has three self-service public elevators. Locations are marked on the Museum map.

SPECIALIZED TOURS

Guided Touch Tours are available for visitors who are blind or have low vision. Participants are provided tactile objects and "hands-on paintings" for use while exploring the Museum's collections. Sign language interpreters are also available for tours. All specialized tours must be booked at least four weeks in advance. OUTREACH TRUNKS FOR EDUCATORS

Joslyn offers two traveling outreach trunks designed specifically for students with special needs. There are also several trunks that have braille and large print object labels available.
