

Joslyn Art Museum Cleaning Protocol

In response to COVID-19 and in adherence to city, state, and federal guidelines, Joslyn Art Museum has taken a number of steps to ensure a safe environment for our visitors. Below is a summary of the Museum's current cleaning protocol.

A disinfectant approved as a cleaning agent by the Douglas County Health Department and the Environmental Protection Agency will be used on all surfaces.

Front Desk Countertop

Sanitized after each visitor

Frequently Touched Surfaces

Sanitized 3–4 times per day

Includes: door knobs, door handles, countertops, handrails, benches

Restrooms

Sanitized 4 times per day

Includes: stall door handles, toilet seats, urinals, soap dispensers, and flat surfaces

(restroom entrance/exit doors, flush mechanisms, water faucets, and paper towel dispensers are touch-free)

Elevator Buttons

Sanitized 6 times per day

Wheelchairs, scooter, strollers

Sanitized after each use

Lockers

Sanitized after each use
