





- Conservation and reattribution of Rembrandt's Portrait of Dirck van Os (ca. 1658) completed;
 painting unveiled in galleries
- Reinstallation of modern and contemporary permanent collection galleries
- First-ever in-gallery conservation project Thomas Moran's The Pearl of Venice (1899)
- Seven of nine exhibitions on view at the Museum organized by Joslyn, including the CAP Gallery series; Yellowstone and the West: The Chromolithographs of Thomas Moran (traveled to two other venues); and In Living Color: Andy Warhol & Contemporary Printmaking from the Collections of Jordan D. - Annual budget grew 5% in 2014; up 20% since 2010
- Endowment balance grew 6% in 2014; up 28% since 2010
- Creation of Anne M. Shaughnessy Endowment Fund in support of education
- Creation of Graham and Sally Lusk Lecture Fund
- \$5.4 million raised to date for capital repairs; \$2.5 million completed in 2014
- Transition of sculpture garden/property maintenance to a predominantly organic program




