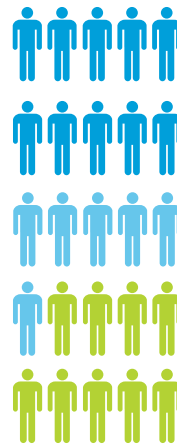

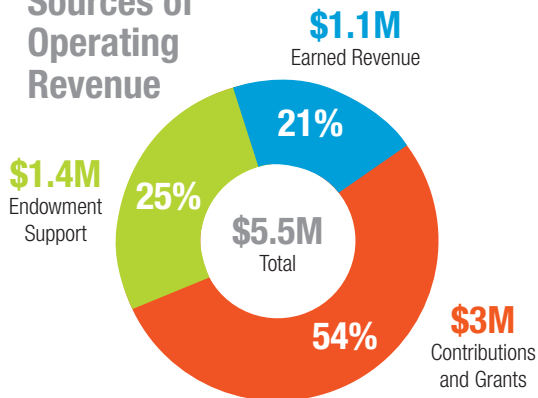

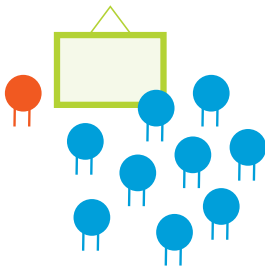

# 2014 Accomplishments

## Spaces & Programs

- Opening of Karen and Doug Riley Contemporary Artists Project (CAP) Gallery
- Opening of interactive space Art Works: A Place for Curiosity
- First year of ownership of Kent Bellows Studio and management of Kent Bellows Mentoring Program

## Collections & Exhibitions

- Conservation and reattribution of Rembrandt's *Portrait of Dirck van Os* (ca. 1658) completed; painting unveiled in galleries
- Reinstallation of modern and contemporary permanent collection galleries
- First-ever in-gallery conservation project — Thomas Moran's *The Pearl of Venice* (1899)
- Seven of nine exhibitions on view at the Museum organized by Joslyn, including the CAP Gallery series; *Yellowstone and the West: The Chromolithographs of Thomas Moran* (traveled to two other venues); and *In Living Color: Andy Warhol & Contemporary Printmaking from the Collections of Jordan D. Schnitzer and his Family Foundation* (traveled to five other venues)
- Works from Joslyn's collection on view in exhibitions at:
  - Amon Carter Museum of American Art (Fort Worth, TX)
  - Denver Art Museum (Denver, CO)
  - Institute for the Study of the Ancient World, New York University (New York, NY)
  - Mississippi Museum of Art (Jackson, MS)

## Education & Outreach

- Community outreach conducted:
  - weekly at Boys Town National Research Hospital, Omaha Home for Boys, and NorthStar
  - monthly with Nebraska Medicine pediatric patients and Siena/Francis House shelter guests
  - occasional programs and workshops for families at the Learning Community Center of South Omaha and Karen immigrants/refugees attending Omaha Public Schools
- Collaborative programming presented with organizations as diverse as FBI Citizens Academy, Omaha Fashion Week, Nebraska Watershed Network, Omaha Yoga & Bodywork Center, Maha Music Festival, and Lewis and Clark National Historic Trail

## Financials & Building/Grounds

- Annual budget grew 5% in 2014; up 20% since 2010
- Endowment balance grew 6% in 2014; up 28% since 2010
- Creation of Anne M. Shaughnessy Endowment Fund in support of education
- Creation of Graham and Sally Lusk Lecture Fund
- \$5.4 million raised to date for capital repairs; \$2.5 million completed in 2014
- Transition of sculpture garden/property maintenance to a predominantly organic program

## Attendance

- First complete calendar year of free general admission
- Annual attendance of 163,324 — a 12% increase from 2013; since 2010, annual attendance has increased 37%
- Visitors from 63 foreign countries — a 70% increase from 2013

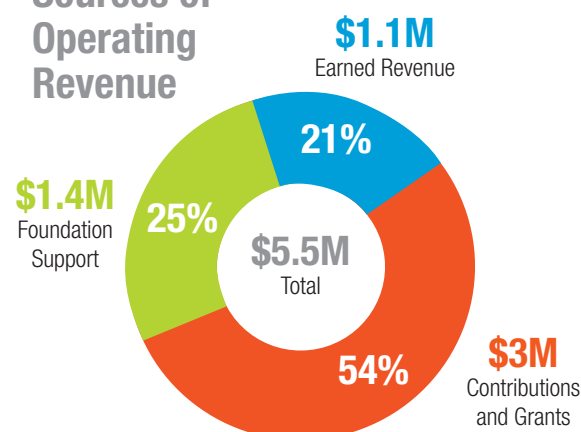

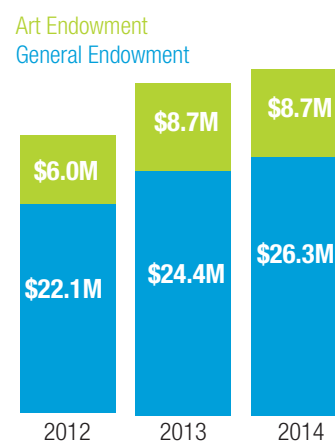
